

STARLIGHT

- 1- Installation and commissioning may only be carried out by authorized specialists. Electrical components must be connected by qualified electricians.
- 2- BEWARE! Make sure the luminaires are always disconnected from the mains supply during wiring, installation and maintenance work. Before starting the installation, make sure the power is switched off.
- 3- This fixture is suitable for indoor use only (not suitable for wet area). The luminaire is exclusively used for lighting and is to be installed in accordance with the national regulations. Any other use or installation is regarded as "non according to instructions".
- 4- The luminaire with F mark is suitable for installation on normally flammable surfaces (for example wood and wood-based materials of more than 2 mm thickness).
- 5- Do not put the luminaire on surfaces that are wet, recently painted or on electrical connections.
- 6- Always be sure to keep a minimum spacing of more than 0.5m (50cm) between the luminaire and the illuminated surface.
- 7- Do not cover the luminaire. Be really careful with insulating material. Avoid excess of dust deposition over the luminaire.
- 8- **Ceiling installation only:**
Make a hole of diameter Φ 33mm for code 9017 and 9019 and ϕ 41mm for 9018.
Connect the LED driver to the existing power cable.
Connect the luminaire to the LED driver.
Insert the luminaire in the hole by **rotating it clockwise**.
- 9- Cleaning is limited to the external parts of the luminaire. During cleaning, make sure that moisture has not penetrated the luminaire or its electrical parts.
- 10- The fitting is using one LED microchip, which is held on the body by two small screws. After 50.000 hours of operation you have to change it.
Keep in mind that the guarantee we are offering you are 50.000 hours or 5 years secure you.



Luminaire without driver: **Protection class III**. Extra low voltage.

Luminaire connected to a driver: **Protection class II**. This fitting is double insulated and should not be connected to ground wire.
